



SUMMER CAMP GUIDELINES

THESE GUIDELINES ARE FOR THE YELLOW PHASE. WE WILL UPDATE WHEN GUIDANCE IS GIVEN FROM THE CDC & GOVERNMENT AGENCIES

You may not enter the building if...

You have a cough, fever, or shortness of breath.

You have a temperature of 100.4 or above.

You have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last two weeks. *This will be at the discretion of our staff.*

CHILDREN are NOT required to wear masks.

ADULTS ARE required to wear masks.

Upon arrival...

Temperatures will be taken by staff.

Hand washing, or sanitizing, will be required.

Camp day...

Car line: We will have a designated drop off & pick up spot in front of the building.

Campers will enter & exit through garage door.

Campers will be separated by age & ability into small groups.

Lunch, snack, craft, & other “group” times will be staggered or split to allow social distancing.

Activities will be designed to promote social distance & for campers to have their own equipment.

When that is not possible, we will hand sanitize & wipe down shared equipment.

We will be doing outdoor activities, as well as indoor.

Staff will wear a mask if they are not able to socially distance 6 feet.

Spotting will occur only if there is a safety concern.

New safety enhancements...

Outdoor sink for washing hands.

Touch free faucets & soap dispensers in bathroom.

Step & Pull door openers.

Touch free hand sanitizers throughout building. LOTS of hand sanitizer available!



Our lobby will be temporarily closed off to parents.
